That changes when you use Box.

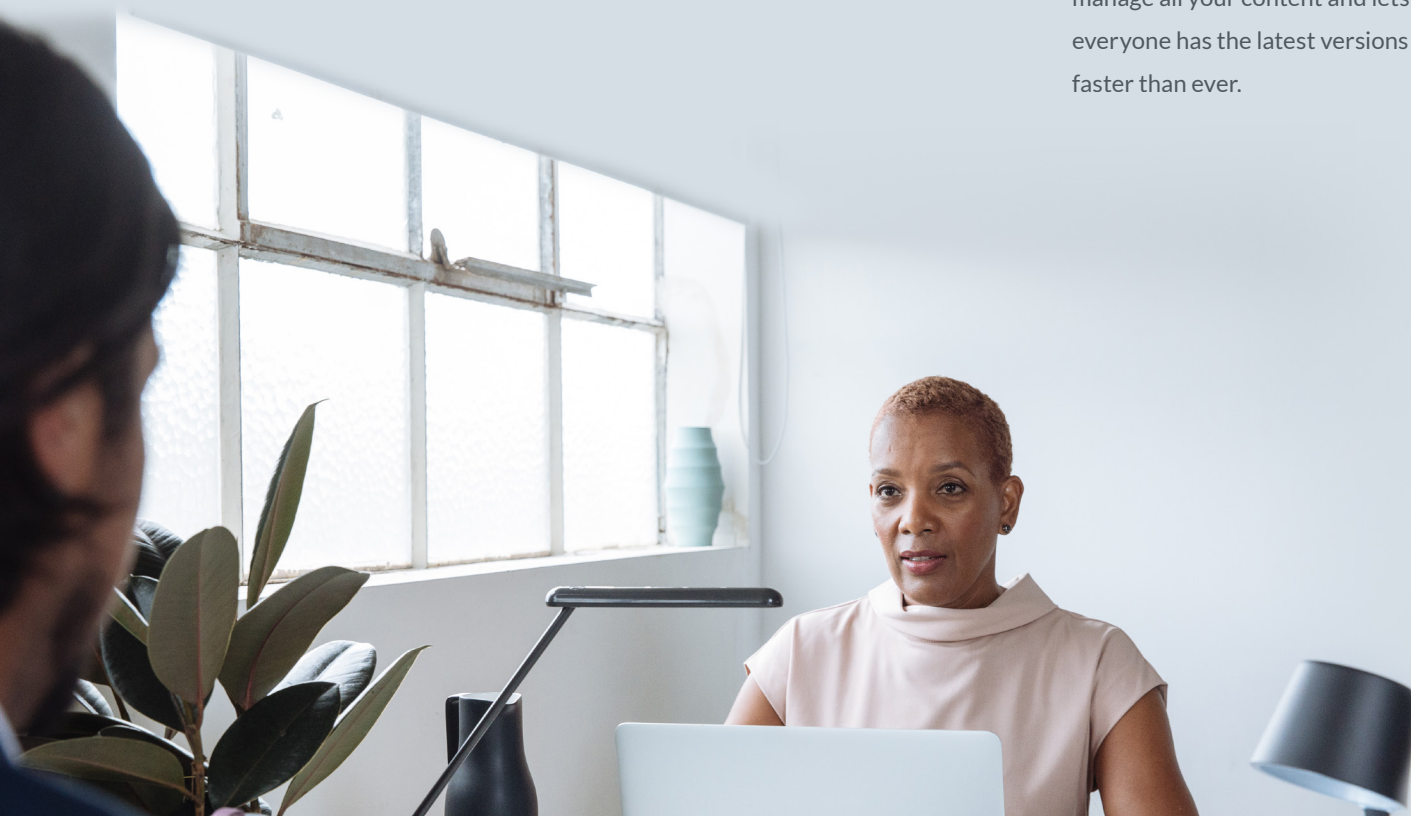

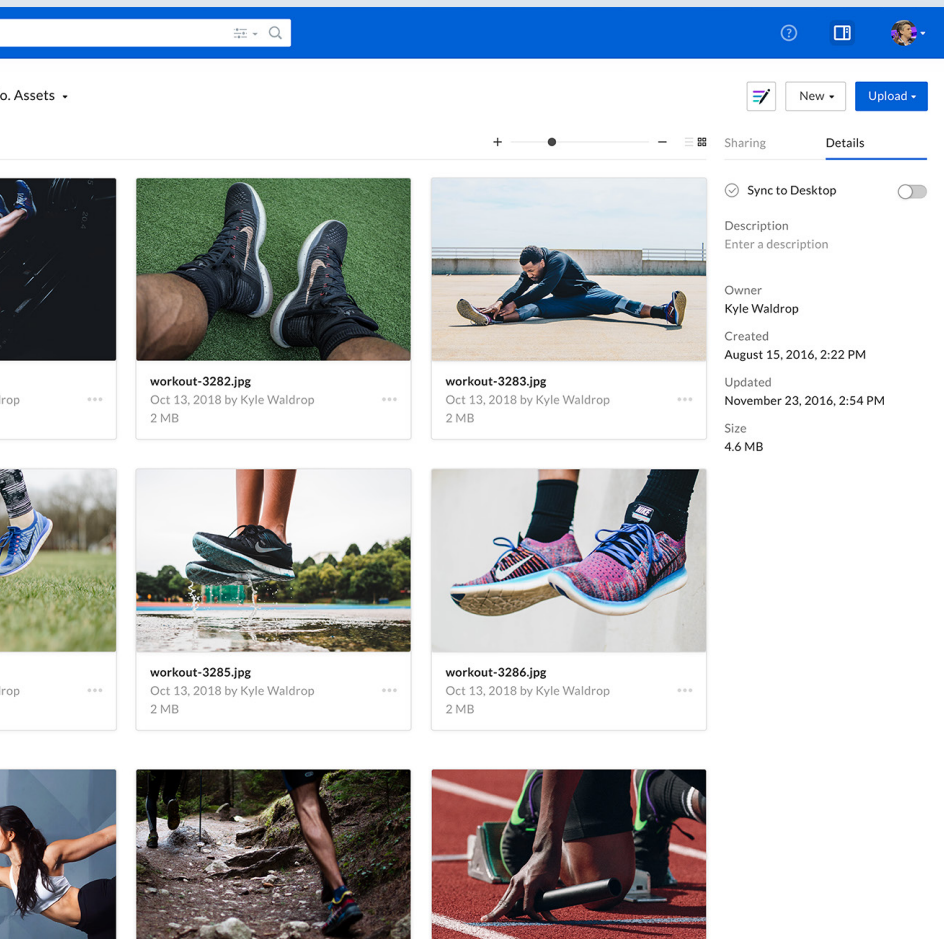
1. Speed up the creative process

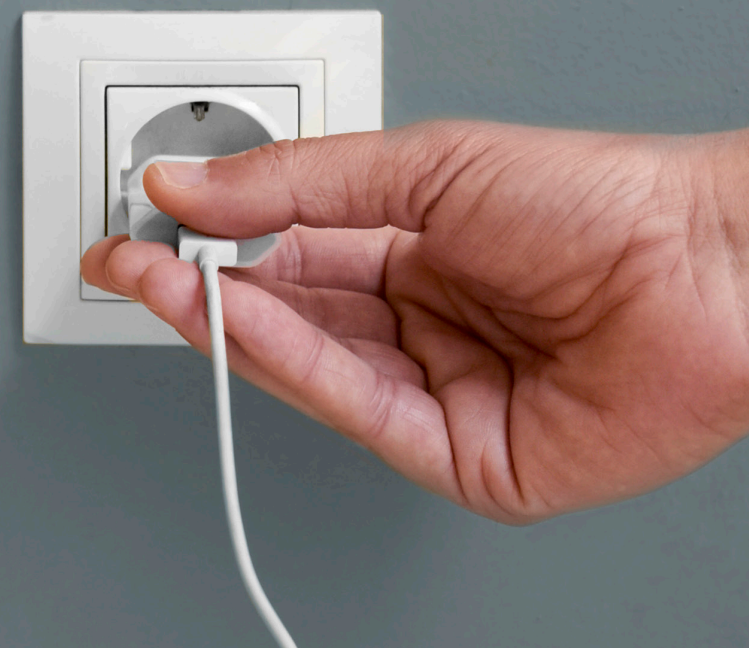
► Publish finalized assets and analyze performance

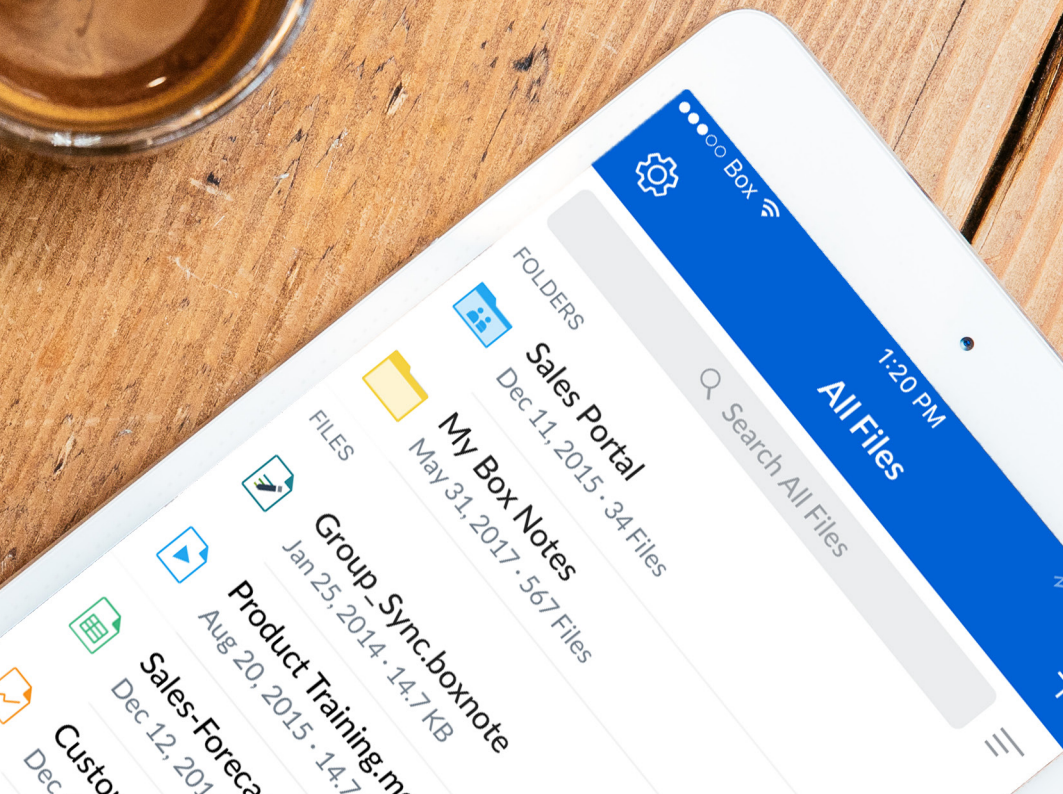
